## OVERVIEW

The Czech Republic aims to bring together the international community to coordinate and efforts for rebuilding health infrastructure, enhance health capacity, and bring effective solutions to hospitals and health institutions in Ukraine. The Global Healthcare Initiative for Ukraine Conference aspires to establish a platform for joint action to help Ukraine health sector.

### **STRENGTHENING CAPACITY AND ACCESS TO HEALTHCARE**

#### **VETERANS' CARE:**

Providing specialized care for veterans including rehabilitation and reintegration into society.

#### **MENTAL HEALTH:**

Addressing the mental health crisis and ensuring access to care.

#### **PRIMARY CARE:**

Enhancing accessibility and quality for primary healthcare services.

#### **SURGICAL AND ICU CAPACITIES:**

Improving surgical and intensive care unit services.

#### **EVACUATION AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES:**

increasing capacities for evacuations and urgent pre-hospital treatment and stabilisation for serious illness and injuries

#### **INFECTION CONTROL AND ANTIBIOTIC RESISTANCE:**

Strategies to prevent healthcare-associated infections and to control the spread of resistant bacteria
