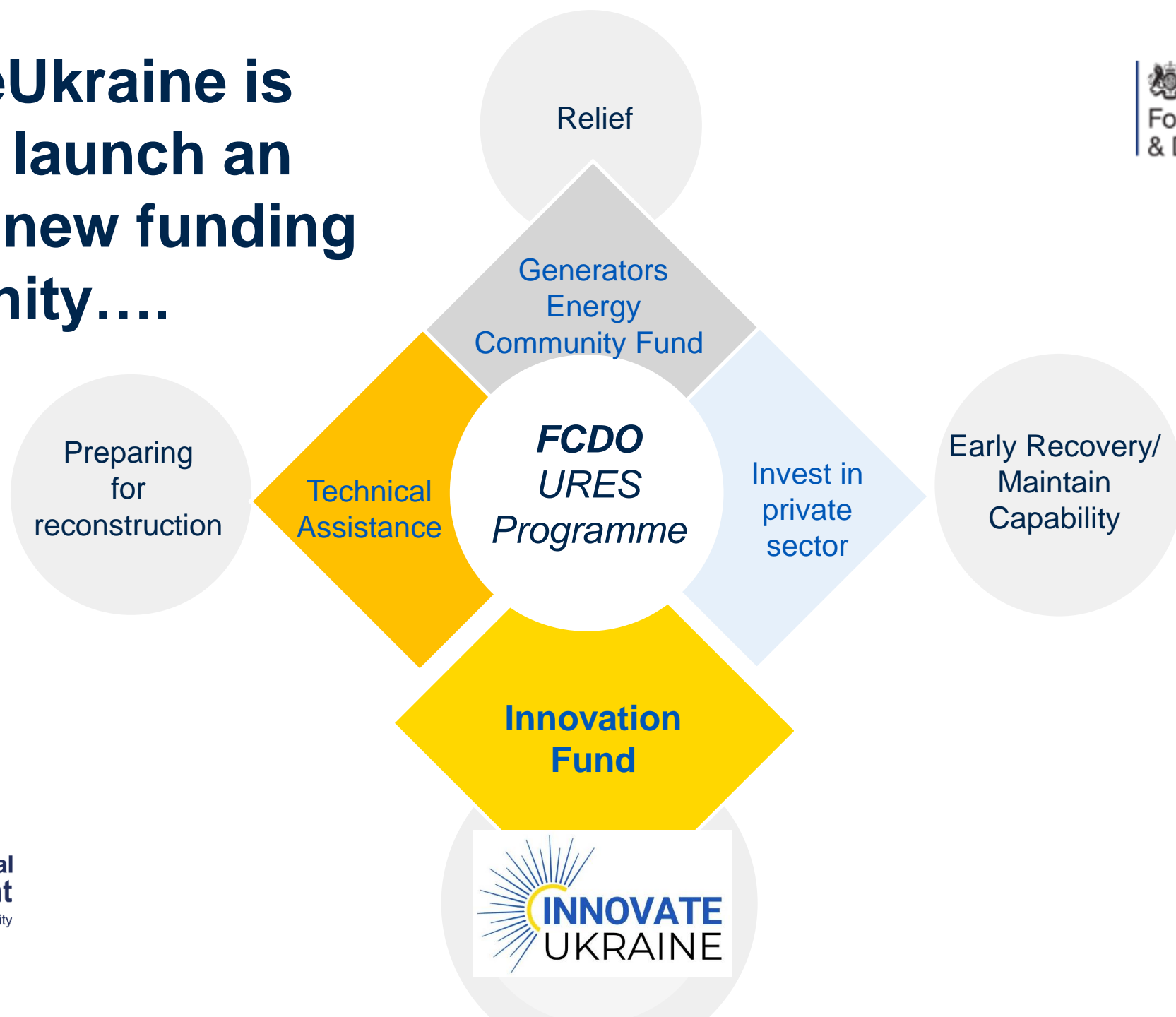

InnovateUkraine Programme Overview



InnovateUkraine is about to launch an exciting new funding opportunity....



Programme Purpose

1. Identify and Support Innovation

To support high impact energy innovation activity in Ukraine which will support the future recovery.

2. Stimulate Activity

To stimulate activity and investment in energy innovation in Ukraine during a period when making progress would otherwise be challenging.



3. Demonstrate

To demonstrate technology in Ukraine wherever possible to prove the concept.

4. Support Commercialisation

To support future steps to commercialise and scale innovations to put Ukraine in the best position to secure its recovery and to create equitable partnerships which can mature and exploit the outputs

Scope and Eligibility

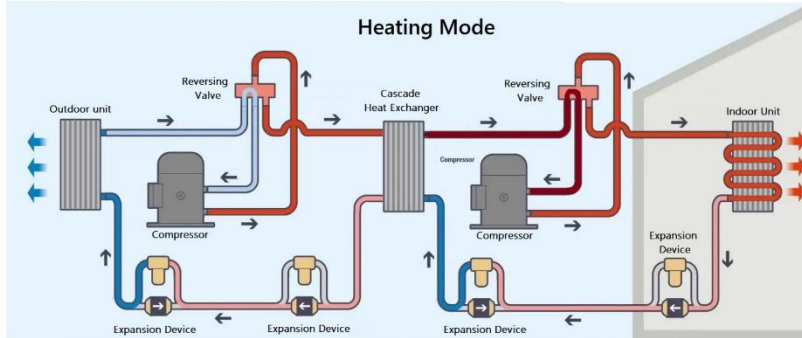
Scope:

- Priority themes are:
 - Smart Green Grids
 - Renewable Generation
 - Renewable heat
 - Green fuels
 - Low-Carbon Buildings and Homes
 - Industrial Decarbonisation
 - Repurposing Existing Energy Infrastructure

Eligibility:

- Key Parameters
 - 1 UK and 1 Ukrainian Partner
 - Industrial Research – Pilot Projects
 - Other partners from anywhere in world
 - Projects up to 24 months
 - £50k - £2m Costs
 - Funding level 50-100%
 - Collaboration must include at least one business

Examples of Projects from Round 1



Dual Heat Pump

Aston University, Institute of Engineering Thermophysics of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine and Heat Pumps VDE LLC
Piloting a new type of heat pump which provides high temperature water in low ambient conditions, easing building retrofit approaches.

AIRFUSE

Airfuse Battery Storage

Rflo, DpSun and Kness

Piloting a new design of flow battery for low cost energy storage technology supporting microgrids and renewable energy storage



S3 – Reconstruction of Ukraine

Universities of Sheffield, Leeds, Oxford, Imperial College, NUWM, Lviv Polytechnic, Eco+Logic, Rethink and C2CA Technology

Piloting a technology which can upcycle the use of recycled concrete for new buildings and structures

Competition Open for applications: June 2023 – September 2023
13 Projects Funded – total of £16m Investment
Projects Run from April 2024-March 2026 (24 Months)



Round 2

Competition Open for applications: 10th March 2025
Applications Close: 23rd May 2025
Total of £17 Investment
Projects Run from January 2026 - December 2027
